ANNUAL ACTIVITIES & ACHIEVMENTS REPORT

Period from 1st April, 2022 to 31st March, 2023

INTRODUCTION

The New Integrated Rural Management Agency (NIRMA) was established in the year 1986 at Nungphou Bazar, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing -795148, Thoubal District, Manipur by same dedicated youth volunteers and social activists as a non-governmental, non-sectarian, non-denomination, non-political, non-profit making voluntary agency with the primary objective of bringing about an overall development/welfare and an equitable/equatorial society in the remote and less privileged areas. The present report highlights the organisation's activities and significant achievement made during the period from 1st April, 2022 to 31st March, 2023.



STRUCTURE OF THE ORGANISATION:

The structure of the organization is democratic. It is well constituted and follows the constitution of the organization. It has General Body Members who are dedicated and committed and well experienced in different fields of rural development, social work and public contact /co-operation. The organization has important office bearers consisting of 3 (three) members-President, Secretary and Treasurer to look after the day-to-day affairs and smooth functioning of the organization.

MANAGEMENT OF NIRMA:

The responsibility and administration of the New Integrated Rural Management Agency (NIRMA) is entrusted to an Executive Committee/ Executive Body/Managing Committee consisting of 7 (seven) members. The General Body Meeting for election of the new members of the Managing Committee of the Organisation held on 14/07/2020 and the elected 7 members of the Managing Committee of the Organisation were approved by the Deputy Registrar of Societies on 23/09/2020.

ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

The Organization has an Advisory Committee consisting of 5 (five) members. The Members of the Advisory Committee were reformed during the period 2020-2021 for a period of 4 years for more development of the Organisation. They overviewed the work of the Executive Committee of the organization and advice the members of the Committee as and when necessary. After completion of the life of an Advisory Committee another new Committee is to be formed by the General Body of the Organization to overview/look after the work and function of the Executive Committee.

During the period 2022-2023, NIRMA have implemented the programme "Maintenance of Senior Citizens' Homes for 50 Beneficiaries" at Nungphou, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur with the revised scheme Atal Vayo Abhyuday Yojana (AVYAY) (Formerly National Action Plan for Senior Citizens (NAPSrC) under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, New Delhi. The Organisation have been running the programme to fulfill the main objective of the scheme i.e., to improve the quality of life Senior Citizens by providing basic amenities like shelter, food, medical, care and entertainment opportunities and by encouraging productive and active ageing through providing support for

The total number of staff in the Senior Citizen's Home were 12 (Twelve) namely (i) Superintendent, (ii) Counselor, (iii) Yoga Therapist (Part time), (iv) Nurse (Part time), (v) Doctor-1(Part time), (vi) Cook-2 (Full time), (vii) Chowkidar-1(Full time), (viii)Helper-2(Full time), and (ix) Cleaner-1(Full time) (x) Accountant to run the Home smoothly, continuously and successfully. The staff visited the Senior Citizen's Home for a minimum of 2 hours per day for 5 days in a week and nurse supplied required medicines regularly to the inmates as prescribed by the Doctor to achieve free from illness. As the nurse was resided near the Senior Citizen's Home, the inmates got regular check-up and supply of medicine. Sometimes, for serious cases, inmates were carried out to the District Hospital, Thoubal, Regional Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), Lamphel, Imphal West, Manipur and Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Medical Sciences (JNIMS), Porompat, Imphal East District, Manipur.

SOME SERVICES RENDERED TO THE INMATES BY THE ORGANIZATION WERE:

(a) Nutrition:

The organization supplied adequate quantity, good quality, variety in food stuff with all the necessary services like fooding, breakfast, tea for both day and night and other fooding items like fruits, juice, bread, omelet, butter, meat, fish, and biscuits etc. according to climate conditions and conventional food habits of the inmates and as demanded by the inmates. The daily indicative menu supplied to the inmates is given below: -

3.	Lunch	Chapati, Rice, Dal/ Sambhar, One Green Vegetable, Curd, Salad (daily) Plus Special Meal (Veg/Non-Veg (Meat/Fish) and Sweet (Halwa/ Kheer/ Gulab Jamun, etc.) (twice a week)
4.	Evening Tea	Coffee/Tea and Biscuits/Rusks/Fan Puffs/Bread
5.	Dinner	Chapati, Rice, Dal, Sabji (Seasonal Vegetable), Khichri Plus Special Meal (Veg/Non-Veg (Meat/Fish) and Sweet (Halwa/ Kheer/ Gulab Jamun, etc.) (twice a week)

(b) Medical facilities/Medicare:

The Organization provided first aid kit (as advised by the Doctor of the Home), Glucometer, BP Monitoring Machine, Weighing Machine and Medicine as prescribed by the Doctor of the Senior Citizen's Home. A residence of the Doctor is also available near the Home as per his advice so as to enable him to look after the inmates/beneficiary of the Home regularly. On the other, as the residence of the Nurse namely was Tentha nearest village from the Home, she gave her full help and cooperation to the inmates.

(c) **Recreation:**

NIRMA provided different Books- 5 numbers, Magazines-4 Nos., newspapers of local language (4 local papers), journals, historical books, novels, morning and evening walking, minor physical exercise to the capable inmates, etc. and religious congregation-reading of Quran and Tradition-once in a week. Facility for meeting with relatives, cultural meet, film show were also provided. The NIRMA provided Games like caroms, chess, radios, T.V.s with cable connection of TATA SKY, film show-Cultural and Geographical shows(Once in a week) and other items like slates, chalks, pencils, exercise books, primary books for adult literacy, etc. From the above items the inmates able to know the efficient knowledge of past and present situation of Manipur and World.

(d) **Clothing-**

Keeping in view local climate, weather conditions and traditional norms, the Organization provided 4 pairs of clothing like Sarwar-Kurta/ Saree-Blouse-Petticoat/Shirt-Point/ Kurta Pyjama /Dhoti-Kurta/ Lungi-Kurta/Phanek (traditional cloth of women of Manipur)/towel and Woolens every year and Mosquito Net, Banket, Pillow and other winter and summer clothes including sandal/ chapless to each and every beneficiary/inmate. The Organization have provided other day by day necessary items like soap, hair oil, tooth brush, tooth paste and dettol soap and other soap from time to time and comb, mirror etc. to the inmates to fulfill their necessity.

(e) **Hygiene and Sanitation:**

The Organization have 3 staff for the project namely Chowkidar, Helper and Cleaner as per guideline of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Ageing Section, Government of India, New Delhi and they cleaned all the Rooms, Verandah/Courtyard and Kitchen at least 2 times a day and toilets at least 3 times a day.

(f) **Miscellaneous payments-**

Payments for electricity, water, internet, stationary, postage, maintenance of furniture, generator/inverter, cost of fuel for cooking, replacement of bed sheets were included for Miscellaneous payments.

(g) **Items for Non-Recurring Grants-**

The main items included in the Non- Recurring Grants were:- Furniture, Chairs, Beds and mattresses(along with Bed Sheets and Pillows), Almirahs, Utensils, Gas Stove, Fan, Desert Cooler, Water Purifier, Grinder/Juicer, Hot Case/Microwave Oven, Water Tank, Electric Motor & Pump, Washing Machine, Television, Computer, Refrigerator, Inverter, Water Cooler, Geyser, etc.

(h) **Vegetable Gardening:**

Now a days, Vegetable Growers used various patricides to all commonly used vegetables like Potato, Guard, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Brinjal, Pumkin, Green Peas, Tomato, Ginger, Garlic, Onion, Chilli, Coriander, Spring Onion, Cucumber, Spinach, Ribbed Guard, etc. available in the local markets. The Senior Citizen's Home have a piece of land near the Home. We have planted all the commonly used vegetables in the Senior Citizens Home to the piece of land (Kitchen Garden) just near the Home without any patricides. The capable inmates involved in the gardening of different kinds of vegetable to the kitchen garden.

(i) **Vocational Training:**

The organization has given vocational training to the capable inmates for making of agarbati, fishing net and mat from kauna crafts, etc. The income received from the sale of the finished goods used as their own money. NIRMA purchased the raw materials of the vocational training cum production centre in the Home.

NIRMA COMPUTER ACADEMY:

The organization has been running NIRMA Computer Academy (NCA) at Old Lambulane, Jail Road, Imphal West District, Manipur since the year 1999 under the sponsorship of the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL), Ministry of Education, Department of Higher Education, Government of India, New Delhi with Centre Code 220002. The name of the course was "Diploma in Computer Application, Business Accounting and Multilingual DTP (CABA-MDTP)" approved by NSDA (Level), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India. Eight (8) students for July Session, 2022 and 15 students for the January Session, 2023 have been registered with the objective of promoting, developing and propagating Urdu Language and to take action for making available in Urdu language the knowledge of scientific and technological development of the NCPUL. The Certificate of the course was jointly certified by National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL), Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of India and National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), Chandigarh, Ministry of Information Technology and Communication, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

NIRMACOMPUTER TRAINING CENTRE:

The program was the second computer centre in Manipur State sponsored National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL), Ministry of Education, Department of Higher Education, Government of India, New Delhi which was commenced from the year 2001 at Nungphou Bazar, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur having Centre No. 220001. It was known as Thoubal Centre and name of the diploma course was "Certificate in Computer Application, Business Accounting and Multilingual DTP (CABA-MDTP)" approved by NSDA (Level), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India. A number of 24 students for July Session, 2022 and 21 (twenty one) students for the January Session, 2023 were registered. The Certificate of the course was jointly certified by National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL), Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of India and National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), Chandigarh, Ministry of Information Technology and Communication, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

CONTINUATION PROJECTS OF NIRMA WITH ONE TIME GRANT AND RUN FROM THE OWN SOURCE OF THE ORGANISATION:

MAULANA AZAD CRAFT TRAINING CENTRE:

The programme had been running since 1st April, 2004 at Nungphou Bazar, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur under Maulana Azad Education Foundation (MAEF), Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India, New Delhi by giving craft training to poor, minority and other backward classes from the rural villages of Thoubal District of Manipur on the trades- Cutting Tailoring and Embroidery. During the period, the programme was conducted from the own fund of the organization as one time grant for purchase of machine and equipments and 20 numbers rural poor women and girls were facilitated. A sum of Rs. 33,100/- was incurred in the programme from the own funds of the organization.

PROMOTION OF WEAVING TECHNOLOGY:

The project was commenced from 1st April, 2001 at Yangbi Leikai, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur under the National Research Development Corporation (NRDC), Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India, New Delhi from the own source of the organization as the project was one time grant. The main objective of the project was to give them self-help, self-reliant and self-sustained to the rural poor beneficiary. Some trained and passed out trainee/beneficiary have got job to other shops, production centre and some have confined to their own production centre. During the period, 20 beneficiaries (women and girls) were facilitated and a sum of Rs. 33,100/- was incurred in the program.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CENTRE:

NIRMA has been implementing the program since 1st April, 1988 at Nungphou Bazar, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur under the Nehru Yuva Kendra, Thoubal District, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India, New Delhi. During the period the organization conducted the program from the own funds of NIRMA as the program was one time project of the NYK by providing local and national papers with magazines and journals etc. to increase the knowledge of the youths. The main objective of the centre was to give and increase knowledge of youths of the neighboring villages and public. The Management Committee took the initiative for look after the day-to-day work and function of the Centre. A sum of Rs. 11,000/- was incurred in the programme.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN PC & MOBILE /CELL PHONE REPAIRING:

The programme was one time project of the National Research Development Corporation (NRDC), 20-22/ Zamroodpur Community Centre, Kailash Colony Extension, New Delhi (A Govt. of India undertaking), Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The organization has been continuously running the project since the year 2009 at Nungphou Bazar, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur. A number of 20 beneficiaries belong to poorest of the poor youths were selected to give self-help, self-reliant and self-sustained and solved socio-economic problem of their family. During the period the programme was conducted from the own funds of the organization. An amount of Rs. 29,000/- was incurred by the organization from its own funds.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE IN TAILORING, EMBROIDERY & WOOL KNITTING:

The Central Waqf Council, Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi had released the financial assistance only for purchase of tools and equipments as one time grant and the organization has been continuously running the programme since the 1st April, 2015 at Yangbi Leikai, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur. The organization conducted the programme on the trades-Tailoring, Embroidery and Wool-Knitting from its own funds and 20 numbers of youths mainly women & girls belongs to Minority Muslim Communities from Thoubal District of Manipur and from poorest of the poor family have been selected and the programme. An amount of Rs. 58,500/- was incurred from its own funds.

CONTINUATION PROJECTS RUN BY NIRMA FROM ITS OWN SOURCES:

AAN COACHING INSTITUTE:

The project was one of the ongoing projects of NIRMA run from its own funds. The organization has been running the program since the year 2007 at Nungphou Bazar, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur for the welfare of the poor and needy students and unemployed youths. The coaching were 2 types (i) for general education from class V to XII standard and (ii) for entrance examinations. Coaching for entrance examinations included- i) entrance examinations for admission in technical and professional courses; ii) private sector and boarding facility for distance students was also provided in the coaching centre. During the period, 30 students for general classes and 20 students for technical and professional courses were facilitated.

URDU STUDY CENTRE:

The project was commenced from the year 2013 at Patkha Leikai, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District Manipur. The centre was arranged with the objective of imparting knowledge and skills of writing and reading of Urdu Language from the basic levels. During the period, the program was facilitated by 2 expert teachers with 50 students from different villages of Thoubal District. An amount of Rs. 26,700/- was incurred in the program from the own funds of the organization.

PROMOTION OF BEE KEEPING:

The project was also one of the ongoing projects of NIRMA run from its own funds since the last many years. During the period also the organization organized 2-days training on "Bee Keeping" from

21-22 December, 2022 at the Training Hall of NIRMA with the participation of 40 participants who were facilitated by 2 experts from the Department of Horticulture, Government of Manipur. An amount of Rs. 8,300/- was incurred in the program from the own funds of the organization.

CARPENTRY TRAINING CUM PRODUCTION CENTRE:

The project was commenced from 12th April, 2015 at Cherapur, Sangaiyumpham Part-II, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal, Manipur from the own source of the organization. NIRMA has been continuously running the program since its inception as one of the ongoing programs run by NIRMA from its own funds. NIRMA conducted one month training program of the same project for the new beneficiaries/trainee by selecting ten numbers of trainee from the poorest of the rural poor family. The centre produced different items/designs of furniture like bed, table, chair, dining table; all furniture items for marriage and any wooden item ordered by locality or purchaser. The main objective of the program was to give self-help, self-sustain and self-sustain to the rural poor educated youths. Many artisans, who have trained from the centre, had opened their own production centre to solve their socio-economic problems. An amount of Rs. 35,500/- was incurred in the program from the own funds of the organization.

GENERAL PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTED BY NIRMA DURING THE YEAR 2022-23 FROM THE OWN SOURCE OF THE ORGANISATION

DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF DR. BHIMRAO AMBEDKAR:

As in previous years, NIRMA organized the Birth and Death Anniversary of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar on 14th April, 2022 and 6th December, 2022 at Community Hall, Sangaiyumpham, Thoubal District, Manipur. Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar popularly known as **Babasaheb Ambedkar** was born on 14th of April in 1891 and Ambedkar Jayanti is celebrated by the people of India to commemorate Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's immense contributions for the poor people of India. Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar is the father of Indian Constitution who had drafted the Constitution of India and he was the great human rights activists. He had established the "**Bahishkrit Hitkarini Sabha**" in the year 1923 in India aiming to spread the necessity of education as well as enhancing the economic status of the low group people of India. He run a social movement for people using slogan "**Educate-Agitate-Organize**" aiming to eradicate the asterism in India as well as rebuilding the Indian Society by following the rule of equality of human beings.

He paid his major contribution by protecting the **Fundamental Rights** (for the social freedom, equality and eradication of untouchably for low group people) and **Directive Principles** (enhancing the living status by securing the fair distribution of wealth) of State Policy in the Indian Constitution. He continued his social revolution till the end of his life. He has been honored with the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian award in the month of April in 1990 for his big contributions towards the Indian society. He died on 6 December 1956. The programme was facilitated by 3 experts with 70 participants. An amount of Rs. 5,000/- was incurred in the program from the own funds of the organization.

AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PANDEMIC:

NIRMA organized the program for one day on 14th August, 2022 at its Training Hall from the own source of the organization. Two expert resource persons from the Medical Department, Government of Manipur delivered valuable talks about the program and 50 participants took part the program. An amount of Rs. 3,700/- was incurred in the program from the own funds of the organization.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING FOR REGISTERED LABOURS AND THEIR DEPENDENT SPOUSE/CHILD/SIBLINGS:

The organization organized 3-Months Short Term Computer Training Course' for Labours and their Dependent Spouse/Child/Siblings from 1st May, 2022 to 31st July, 2022 at the NIRMA Computer Training Centre (NCTC), Nungphou Bazar, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District,

Manipur. The main objective of the programme were (i) To give Computer training to the registered building workers and their dependent spouse/child/siblings; (ii) To give self-employed and entrepreneurship ideas; (iii) To create an atmosphere of competition and exploring for living and help them to utilize the leisure time properly; (iv) To rise up socio-economy of the entrepreneurs to registered building labour workers family members, their dependent spouse/child/siblings on the proposed project; (v) to build awareness about the income activities. A number of twenty beneficiaries from registered building workers and their dependent spouse/child/siblings were facilitated.

WORKSHOP ON DRUG ABUSE AND ALCOHOLISM:

As the Organisation can't remain dormant in the ever increasing number of immoral drug users and trafficking, it organized this program as a participant(warrior) of the war on drugs. The workshop was organized with the primary objectives to sensitize and inculcate in the minds of the masses the immoral drug trafficking, abusing drugs and intoxicants and harmful effects leading to grave problems. The workshop was held at the Training Hall of NIRMA on 6th January, 2023 with the participation of 30 youths who were facilitated by 2 experts from the CMO office, Government of Manipur. An amount of Rs. 3,800/- was incurred by the organization from its funds.

CHILD CARE CENTRE:

NIRMA organized the program as continuation project as it was started from the year 2017 at Patkha Leikai, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, P.O. Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur from the own source of the Organisation. Child care (day care) is the care and supervision of a child or multiple children at a time, whose ages range from six weeks to thirteen years. Child care providers can be children's first teachers, and therefore play an integral role in systems of early childhood education. Quality care from a young age can have a substantial impact on the future successes of children. The main focus of childcare is on the development of the child, whether that be mental, social, or psychological. So far about 250 (Two hundred fifty) children have been facilitated.

TRAINING IN FISH FARMING:

It was one of the ongoing programs of NIRMA and implemented as usual at Mamang Pat, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, Thoubal District, Manipur. The organization conducted the program for 2-days on 26th June, 2022. The main objectives of the programme were to provide training to fish farmers and fishermen for improving their skill in fish farming and fishing, training is required. Fishery sector occupies a very important role in the socio-economic development of the State and the country as well. It has been recognized as a powerful income and employment generator. In Manipur out of the 52,000 metric tons of fish required for consumption only 32,000 metric tons are being produced by the fish farmers of the Manipur State annually. So, fish farming was very easy, suitable and income generating program for the unemployed youths of Manipur. The organization conducted one day training of the program with 30 fish farmers who were facilitated by 2 expert resource persons from the Fishery Department, Government of Manipur. An amount of Rs. 4,500/- was incurred by the organization from its funds.

TRAINING IN POULTRY FARMING:

The organization conducted the above training programs at its Training Hall for one Day on 9th December, 2022 with the participation of 40 rural people (men and women) from neighboring villages of Sangaiyumpham Part-I. The programme was facilitated by 2 experts from the Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Manipur. The program was intended to impart skills and mobilize the participants to improve their social and economic conditions. An amount of Rs 3,800/- was incurred in the program from the own source of the organization.

ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

The organization conducted the program for one day on 19th February, 2023 at Community Hall, Sangaiyumpham Part-I, Thoubal District, Manipur. Road safety campaigns are an important way to spread awareness among people about road safety measures and rules. Road safety is crucial to save millions of lives and prevent injuries. The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways also

attributes the cause of crashes to carelessness or lack of road safety awareness. The program was facilitated by 2 experts from the Transport Department, Govt. of Manipur with 50 participants from representatives of Clubs/NGOs/Assns./Mahila Mandals and others such as driver, owner, school and college students, etc. An amount of Rs. 3,500/- was incurred by the organization from its funds in the programme.

HIV/ AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

The program was organized for one day on 11th September, 2022 at Tentha, Thoubal District, Manipur. The aim of the HIV/AIDS Awareness Programme was-i) to empower and increase the awareness to participants of HIV/AIDS, its impact, management and availability of support systems and this was to encourage early testing and lifestyle changes that will thereby reduce and prevent further infection and ii) to empower and increase the awareness to participants of HIV/AIDS, its impact, management and availability of support systems. Two experts from Health Department, Government of Manipur facilitated the programme with 40 participants. An expenditure amount of Rs.3,200/- was incurred by the organization from its funds in the programme.

SENSITIZATION CAMP FOR YOUTH AND ADOLESCENTS:

Bringing youth and adolescents in the main stream of social life being a main concern of the organization, NIRMA organized it for one day on 7th March, 2023 at its Training Hall with the main objective of imparting an indepth awareness to the youth and adolescents who would become the pillars of tomorrow's nation and they should well aware that man is the architect of his own fate keeping themselves far away from every anti-social and anti-national feelings and activities. The program was facilitated by 2 experts from the Youth and Affairs Department, Government of Manipur with 40 youth participants. The expenditure was Rs 3,300/- incurred from local support and organisation's own funds.

DISASTER MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:

The organization organized it on 27th November, 2022 at Phundrei, Thoubal District, Manipur. The main objective of the programme were-Reduce Damages and Deaths; Reduce Personal Suffering; Speed Recovery and Protect Victims. Resource persons from the concern department of the Government of Manipur delivered valuable talks about the programme and expressed that there are different types of disaster management such as Natural Disasters; Man-Made Disasters; Complex Emergencies; Pandemic Emergencies; Disaster Prevention; Disaster Preparedness; Disaster Response/Relief and Disaster Recovery. A number of 50 participants were facilitated from the program.

CENTENARY AND ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION:

NIRMA organized the birth anniversary of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru on 14th November, 2022 at Community Hall, Sangaiyumpahm Part-I, Thoubal, Manipur to commemorate his birthday. The program was presided Md. Hibjur Rahaman, Hon'ble Zilla Parishad Member, Thoubal Zilla Parishad, Sangaiyumpahm Kendra. Three expert resource persons delivered valuable speech about the programme. Altogether 80 participants took part the program. An amount of Rs.4,500/- was incurred by the organization from its funds in the programme.
